Session II: Report on the Researchers' Meeting

Yesterday we had the second researchers meeting. I would like to express my **many** thanks to Chinese colleagues who prepared and hosted such a beautiful meeting. I wish to highlight some significant achievements of the meeting.

Firstly, seven distinguished researchers from three countries made informative presentations which provided us many new ideas, such as 5W research proposal of Korean friends and low carbon economy of Chinese friends.

Secondly, we discuss the first CJK Global Compact Joint Survey which was six-month project to ask GC participating companies about their practices on the GC and CSR and completed in June. Every reporter and commentators admitted this great achievement and showed their expectation about our friendship and cooperation in the future.

Thirdly, we moved to academic discussion on the current situation on CSR reporting among three countries. This discussion gave us more clear understanding and it is going to be a common base for our future research on CSR Reporting.

Finally, we reached to discussion on the third meeting in Tokyo in 2011. We re-recognized that this researchers meeting should keep its academic approach. Three researcher teams will engage in one-year research on the common topic, CSR Report Research and bring this result to the Tokyo meeting.

We, China, Japan and Korea, have been working together for the meeting and survey as an equal research partner. This spirit of friendship and fairness should be kept in the third meeting as well.
